


Installation Notes TecLocal – Multi Access

These notes describe certain features in the installation of the Multi-user solution for the purchaser. They should be read in conjunction with the document "TecLocal 3.0 – Installation and User Help", which contains the basic information about online switching and to which the section references relate. You find the document on TecCom CD in path TecCom\Documents\2 Installation Guide\Language\TecGo Online 3.0.

 The multi user installation based on Access database is recommended for up to 10 users.

Requirements:

- Network drive for the whole MS Access application database to be used
- Several PCs on the local network
- Network drive path always connected
- Router with ISDN line or Internet access for all PCs for communication with the TecCom network

Installation of the first TecLocal:

- 1 Insert the TecCom CD. From the Start menu, select **Installation** (see sect. II. of "Go Online"). If the starting screen does not appear automatically, open it with a double click on the file "tecstarter.hta".
- 2 After selecting the desired language select the following installation options:
Role: as Orderer
Operation Mode: as Multi-user solution
- 3 In the installation dialog box, select: **Application or application components** and **Application and protocol database**.
This will also install the MS Access database for shared use on the network drive as well as the TecLocal on the PC.
- 4 Select destination paths for installation and complete the installation.
- 5 Use the Windows Explorer to share the TecLocal folder. Allow full access to the network drive (read, write, execute).
This is the folder of the MS Access application database. Additional PCs will connect to this folder.
- 6 Continue with sect. III. Online setup.
All settings concerning organization, users, suppliers etc. and the initial connection authentication must only be set on the first client. TecCom system administrator rights will automatically be allocated to the first user from a productive organization upon productive switching.
- 7 Create user IDs for additional users of TecLocal.

Installation of additional TecLocals:

- 1 Use the Explorer to connect the network path, which is shared on first PC. Network drive path has to be connected permanently.
- 2 Insert the TecCom CD. From the Start menu, select **Installation** (see sect. II.).
- 3 After selecting the desired language select the following installation options:
Role: as Orderer
Operation Mode: as Multi-user solution
- 4 In the installation dialog box, only select the installation option **Application or application components**.

- 5 For the second to nth installation, the target path (.../TECCOM/Database/) for the shared usage MS Access application database on the network drive is given.

N.B.: The following question: *"Installing - The directory already exists. Do you really mean this directory?"* must be answered with **YES!**

Checking of TecLocal:

After installation, setup of additional installations of TecLocal and connection to the TecCom network run TecLocal, login with a valid user ID and send an order to the TEC-Testsupplier (see document TecLocal 3.0, which you find on the TecCom CD in the path TecCom\Documents\3 User Guide\Language\TecLocal 3.0).
